

Enterphone Features

Two quick rings mean someone's here to

see you. When you receive calls from the lobby, your phone will ring with a distinctive sound -two quick rings. Answer your phone and talk to your visitor. Simply hang up to refuse entry.

Just dial 6 to allow entry. Then hang up. The entrance door will automatically unlock and your visitor can enter.

- If you're talking to a visitor and you hear a soft ringing overtone on your line, it indicates a regular incoming telephone call. Quickly finish your conversation with the visitor.



6 To allow entry, dial "6". You'll then be connected instantly to your incoming call.

3 To refuse entry, dial "3". Then you'll be connected to your incoming call.

- Should you hang up with an outside call waiting, your phone will ring automatically. Answer as normal.

If you're on the phone when a visitor calls, dial 3 to put your conversation on hold. When you're talking on a regular telephone call and you hear a muted double overtone on your line, it indicates a call from the lobby. Dialing 3 will put your outside call on hold and connect you to your visitor.

6 To allow entry, dial "6". You'll be reconnected instantly to your outside call.

3 To refuse entry, dial "3". You'll be immediately reconnected to your outside call.

- Should you hang up with an outside call on hold, your phone will ring automatically. Answer as normal.
